

REGIONAL FOCUS FIRST






Very large proportion of the travelling takes place within a region

CLOSE INTERACTION WITHIN REGION REQUIRED








- Large proportion tendered operation

- Different needs in different regions


REGION ACTING AS ONE SYSTEM








National Access Point






